The College is extremely pleased to announce that our 2016 HSC results are the best in our history, with our graduating students collectively achieving 20 Band 6s (Score of 90 and above) and 56 Band 5s (Score of 80 and above). Most importantly, however, all students have continuously proven themselves to be an outstanding group of young men and women. I'm very proud and honoured to say that I have been associated with them over the past six years. Credit and congratulations must go to all the teachers who have guided our Year 12 students during their time at the College and during this time have continuously offered their support, patience, knowledge and perseverance. I am equally appreciative of our families who have made every effort to build a strong relationship between school and home.

In other exciting news student Tatjana Brandson is the first student in the College's history to graduate with straight Band 6 results. Fellow graduate Patrick McCallum went agonisingly close in achieving the same result – missing this feat by a solitary mark. Patrick did, however achieve the highest ATAR (University Entrance Score) in the Eurobodalla by scoring 98.75 which is also the highest in the College's history. Our Year 12 students achieved Band 6 results in ten separate courses and achieved above State average scores in over 70% of the courses. I now wish them all the very best with the next step in their lives, extremely confident that they will continue to represent themselves, their families and the College with pride and integrity.
