EARLY LEARNING IS FUNDAMENTAL TO THE GROWTH OF YOUR CHILD.

Early childhood experiences deeply affect a child's physical, cognitive, emotional and social development. We recognise the significance of these experiences and value our role as teachers in supporting, nurturing and facilitating the development of children.

COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT

Through an intricate balance of responsive and intentional teaching, teachers guide and support children to learn the foundations of literacy and numeracy through inquiry and play.

SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

When children feel safe, valued and supported they engender a sense of belonging, self-worth and connection to their world. These connections afford children the confidence to effectively navigate social relationships, experiment, explore and discover their world, solve problems, create and innovate, relax, have fun and meaningfully express themselves.

LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

Children are encouraged to use language to investigate and explore, to reflect on their experiences. They are listened to with respect, believing that their questions and observations are an opportunity to learn and search together. Learning is a collaborative process. Rather than the child asking a question and the adult offering the answers, the search is undertaken together.
