



GENERAL EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIPS

Open to new and current students entering Year 7 to Year 11 offering a limited number of scholarships providing up to 75% remission of academic tuition fees for a six-year period, subject to annual review.

General Excellence Scholarships are for areas of general excellence including the academics, the arts, leadership and sport.

The Scholarship is provided for a 6 year period with an annual review.

Applicants need to demonstrate a very high level of performance in at least two of the following categories:

- **Academics** - Applicants are required to provide two of their most recent Semester School Reports (last 12 months), demonstrating a strong commitment to academic learning. Copies of their most recent NAPLAN results and external testing competition results or other supporting relevant academic documentation will also need to be submitted with application.
- **The Arts** - Applicants must have considerable talent in one area of the Arts or have a high level of ability across a number of disciplines with the Arts (Music, Drama, Debating, Public Speaking). Applicants should submit a video of one solo performance piece in the instrumental/music specialisation area.
- **Leadership** - Applicants must be able to demonstrate past and ongoing leadership at their school and within the community. Only applicants of the highest level of character will be considered.
- **Sport** - Applicants must be performing at a very high level in relevant sports. At least one sport (i.e.: participating at State level) or multiple sports if at a lower level, and provide details, including substantiation if required. Scholarship winners will be required to be heavily involved in the College's sport program.

Conditions of Scholarships

- Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Principal.

- The Scholarships are awarded on the condition that the recipient will finish their secondary education at St Peter's Anglican College. Should a Scholarship recipient leave the College prior to graduation they may be required to return the financial award of the Scholarship to the College.
- The continuation of the Scholarship throughout the year is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, displaying conduct of the highest standard and contributing to the life of the School through participation in leadership and other co-curricular activities.
- The College reserves the right to not award Scholarships if there are no suitable applicants.

Application Process

The Scholarship application form should be completed and returned to the College together with:

- Copies of the student's most recent academic reports for the previous 12 months;
- A copy of the student's latest NAPLAN results; and
- A recent character reference from an adult who knows the applicant well and is not related to the applicant.

Interviews

Shortlisted applicants will be contacted to attend an interview with a panel consisting of the Principal, member of the Board and Executive. New parents will have the opportunity to tour the College facilities and meet with staff and student leaders during the student interview.
